

#### **NEW FEATURES**

#### On-Demand Subtitles/Captioning

The ability to upload or manually enter subtitles to an on-demand media has been added within Studio, providing your attendees a way to view the webcast in the language of their choice. Subtitles can be easily added through the media editor and allow for a subtitle track to be configured for all platform supported languages.





#### **Group Chat Controls**




A new set of controls have been added to the Studio group chat, that allows administrators to better moderate the group chat. The following options are now available within the group chat.

- An editable disclaimer can be enabled that requires viewers to opt into the chat before being allowed to enter chat text. When enabled, the disclaimer will appear every time a viewer enters the webcast. (Image 1)
- Moderators can now ban a viewer within the group chat, enabling moderators to remove a viewer who is entering inappropriate comments into the group chat. Once a viewer is banned, they can view the group chat, but they will not be able to submit any chat text. Additionally, if a viewer is accidentally banned, there is the option to unban the viewer. (Image 2)
- A confirmation message will now display, if enabled, for moderators when deleting a group chat entry, so a chat entry is not accidentally deleted. (Image 3)

Note: All of the above options are <u>disabled</u> by default.







#### **Wirecast Source**



A new source type has been added to the presenter console for Wirecast. When selected and saved, moderators can now launch Wirecast directly by clicking the "Launch Wirecast" button in the source details. Additionally, there is a direct link that can be sent to an onsite engineer that they can use to launch Wirecast and have all the Studio settings automatically populated in Wirecast.



# **Screen Share**


The screen share within Studio has been updated to no longer require an extension when screen sharing with the Chrome browser. When speakers launch the "Start Screen Share" button, they will be taken directly into screen sharing and not be prompted to enable the screen share extension.



### **Q&A Answers**



The moderator view of the Studio Q&A panel has been updated to allow moderators to publish a question without providing an answer. This provides moderators with the ability to quickly make a question viewable to the audience without having to first enter an answer.






### **RTMPS Streaming**



The output options within the Monitor Tool of Studio have been updated to support RTMPS streaming. This is required when streaming with Facebook Live as they no longer support RTMP.


#### **NEW FEATURES**

#### **Telephony Integration**

#### **Speaker Bridge**

Studio now has a direct integration into West telephony which allows for reserving a dedicated speaker bridge for the webcast. This has been added with in the Settings section of Studio Webcasting setup. It is also available from within the Studio presenter console.

When using the speaker bridge option, Studio will generate a call-in number, conference code and leader pin. The speaker bridge can be used at ANY TIME once generated. Studio allows for one speaker bridge instance per webcast. In addition, there is no date/time restriction which allows for the speaker bridge to be used on multiple occasions (speaker training, recordings, dry runs, pre-call/live day, etc.)








#### **Operator Assisted (OA)**

In addition to the speaker bridge integration, a Studio webcast can now reserve an operator assisted allocation. An operator assisted allocation allows you to reserve an operator to manage the conference bridge on the live day. In order to reserve an operator assisted allocation, the account must be pre-configured with your OA account number and Owner(s) ID. Please contact your account representative to learn more about obtaining an OA account.






### **Cross Webcast Reporting**

There is a new Cross Webcast Report within Studio Webcasting that provides administrators a dashboard view across multiple webcasts within a given tenant. The dashboard offers administrators the ability to filter their results by date, webcast classifications and webcast category, providing insight into a specific set of webcasts. For example, if clients have configured their classifications around audience or product type, they will be able to get data on what webcasts performed across a specific audience or product type.

Each chart can be exported into excel for deeper analysis and a snapshot of the entire dashboard can be taken and exported into an image for use in PowerPoint or Word.




