


#### **New Features**

## Simulive Auto End

Studio has added the ability to auto end a simulive webcast. This allows for a simulive webcast that will not contain any "live" elements to be automatically ended once the simulive media has completed, removing the need to have a webcast staffer manage the webcast runtime.



The "Auto End" feature was also added to the "Settings" page in Studio Webcasting.











## **Interprefy Panel**

A new Studio layout panel has been added to allow for a tighter integration with one of our translation partners Interprefy. The panel allows for the token to be configured ahead of time, removing the need for the viewers to have to manually enter token upon entry into the webcast.



When a viewer enters the webcast, they will be prompted to select which language they want to receive the audio of the webcast.



Note: The Interprefy panel is not supported on IE 11 or mobile devices.






## **Updates**

#### On Demand Audio Tracks

The multi-lingual feature has been updated to allow for deactivating of audio tracks for on demand playback. This allows webcast owners to customize the on demand experience for the audience and disable any audio tracks that they don't want available. Audio tracks can be reenabled at any time.



# **Kollective Integration**

The Kollective integration has been updated to the new Kollective SDK v2 instance providing viewers with two new features:

- Viewers can now receive the stream via Kollective through WebRTC. This removes the requirement for a viewer to have the Kollective agent installed on their machine.

  Note: The WebRTC connection is not available for viewers on IE 11.
- When viewing on demand, viewers can now receive the stream via Kollective.
   Previously, when viewing on demand the stream was always delivered via the CDN.








## **Simulive Auto Start**

The auto start feature that can be enabled for simulive webcasts has been updated so the webcast will no longer auto start if there are no defined sources in the webcast. This is being done to safeguard the webcast so it will not start and record blank media.



# **Certificates Panel**

The certificate panel has been updated to no longer require the viewer to reload the panel to view their certificate once they have completed all the CPE requirements.






## **WEBCASTING SETUP**

#### **New Features**

#### **Studio Templates**

The ability to create manage Studio templates has been added to Webcasting for Advanced Administrators. Templates are created by copying from an existing webcast or from an existing webcast template.

Within the webcast templates list, Advanced Administrators can view the important information like show key, title, template owner, date last accessed, category, and locked status. If a template is locked it will be available to copied from when creating a new webcast. If a webcast is unlocked, it will not appear in the template list to copy from when creating a new webcast.






## Messaging – vCalendar Template

Within the Messaging section, administrators can configure the vCalendar reminder that gets sent within the Registration Confirmation and Webcast Reminder emails. The template allows you to configure the Location and Body text for the calendar reminder. Additionally, replacement variables can be added to the template, so they are automatically pulled into the calendar reminder.

Note: It is not recommended to use the replacement variable "{Abstract}" if your webcast abstract has html in it as email clients like Outlook will not render the html within the calendar.









#### **New Features**

#### Mass Staff Assignment

Within Content Structure in the Presentations section, there is a new tool called "Mass Staff Upload". This tool allows administrators to quick and easily staff many users across many presentations. Below is the list of features this tool offers:

- Select the presentations that need to be staffed. Either use the drop down to select each
  presentation or paste in a list of EventKeys and the presentations will be added. (Note: Only
  Studio webcasts are supported in this tool)
- Select the users that will be staffed. Either manually enter the email address of each staffer or paste in a list of email addresses. (Note: the staffers must already be setup as users before they can be added.
- If the users have not been registered, a registration package can be applied to all the users being staffed.
- Assign the users a staffer role. This will be the role the staffers will have across all presentations they are being staffed to.

#### **UPDATES**

#### Space Builder – Logo/Front Screen

Within the space builder, sponsors building their space will no longer have to wait several minutes to see the logo or front screen update when using the booth preview. Additionally, a new message has been added to the logo and front screen sections of space builder to alert sponsors that within the attendee view it will take several minutes for these assets to update.

LOGO - Link to an existing logo on the internet or upload a logo.

NOTE: If you link to an existing logo, it must be a JPG or PNG.

Uploaded logos will be converted.

Uploaded logos will take upwards of 5 minutes to update within the attendee view of the event.


## **CROSS-PLATFORM FEATURES**

# **Test Event Notification**

Within Virtual Events and Webcasting, a new feature has been added to signify when an event or presentation is a test and is non-billable.

For Virtual Events, when this field is selected, all presentations in that event will also be flagged as test presentations as you cannot have a billable presentation within a "test" Virtual Event.










Additionally, when this is enabled in a Virtual Event and Studio Webcasting, both the registration and login page will display a "Test" header across the page as shown below.



For billable Virtual Events, if a test presentation is needed within the event, there is now a checkbox at the presentation level. This will be used in reporting to signify that the presentation will not be charged for. In a future product release, there will be restrictions put in place on "test" presentations (i.e. 10 max concurrent viewers).

## **Scribe Connector**

The Scribe Connector has been updated to allow partners like Cvent to seamlessly pass over the sessions/presentations a registrant selected during registration and populate those sessions into the agenda within the Intrado platform. This allows attendees to enter the event and have their session agenda already populated with the sessions they selected during registration on a 3<sup>rd</sup> party platform like Cvent.
